Dr. David W. Graves is a general superintendent in the Church of the Nazarene.

Dr. Graves was chosen for the highest elected office in the denomination at the 27th General Assembly held in Orlando, Florida, USA, in 2009. At the time of his election, Dr. Graves was the senior pastor of College Church of the Nazarene in Olathe, Kansas, where he had served since 2006.

Prior to College Church, he served as director of Sunday School Ministries for the Church of the Nazarene International Headquarters from 2001 to 2006. He has had pastoral assignments in Kansas, Ohio, Tennessee, Oklahoma, and North Carolina.

Dr. Graves is a graduate of Olivet Nazarene University and received his Master of Divinity degree from Nazarene Theological Seminary. He received an honorary Doctor of Divinity from Olivet. He is the author of three books and has written for numerous publications.

Dr. Graves and his wife, Sharon, have four married children, Michael, John, Stephen, Rachel, and 12 beautiful grandchildren.

Rev. Sheila Thompson



Pastor Sheila's call into ministry has been many years in the works. In 2001, she began working in youth ministry as a volunteer. At first, she was reluctant to serve in this capacity, but God had a plan even then. Through the years, Sheila has gone from simply being the adult in charge, to having the desire to lead people to a Christlike life.

Sheila began lay ministry classes in 2005 for youth ministry and then for Lay Pastor through the CLT program. In 2012, Sheila states: "God clearly called me to preach and move toward ordination."

She received her first local license in July 2013, and her first district license in July 2015. She has been extremely blessed to serve as a Youth Pastor for 4 years at Crossroads Community Church. Not only did her pastor, Mark Roberts, direct, mentor, and encourage her every day. She also had her husband, Jack, encouraging and working her along the way. Seeking to continue his education and preparation for the ministry, Matthew completed his Masters of Divinity degree in 2016 at Chapman Seminary at Oakland City University.
