Airport information:

We are flying out of the Indianapolis Airport (7800 Col H Weir Cook Mem Dr). Due to airline restrictions, we will be flying in assigned groups. **Please plan to arrive at the Indianapolis Airport 1.5 hours prior to your group's departure time.** We realize this may be early for some, but we have a large group to get through the airport check-in and security so please be on time. Go to the Southwest Airline location and look for SWID leaders wearing a SWID t-shirt (shirts may not be the same color, but they will be SWID shirts).

Luggage Information:

1 suitcase and 1 carry-on: Luggage must remain under 50lbs. We suggest that you put one change of clothes in the carry-on in the event luggage is lost or delayed. Students are responsible for getting their luggage through the airport. Once again, it will be necessary to arrive on time to get through check-in and security. **Please be on time!**

Things to pack:

Please pack modest clothing – school guidelines can be used. If need be SWID leadership will address clothing issues. If you have any questions, feel free to contact Jason or Amanda. Temperatures and humidity will more than likely be very high, and we will be doing **A LOT of walking** so pack clothes appropriate for warm weather and comfortable walking shoes.

SWID has provided three NYC shirts to wear (please be sure to pack them for the trip). We will be passing those out to church leaders at Teen Camp. At NYC there is a district t shirt day when they encourage districts to wear the same shirt. **We will wear the charcoal grey SWID shirts on Thursday.**

Toiletry items: Hotel will provide towels and washcloths, but please bring soap, <u>deodorant</u>, toothpaste, toothbrush, etc.

All students must bring a picture id (a school id or driver's license would be great).

Please remind your students to stay hydrated! There is no need for a swimsuit, as there will be no opportunities for swimming while we are there.

Every student will receive one NYC backpack and one water bottle on Wednesday. The NYC backpack is the only bag that will be allowed into The Amalie Arena (where we will be having our services). We will also be allowed to take the NYC water bottle into the Arena and Rec Hall, but only that water bottle and ONLY filled with water.

*We will assign one adult with every four students (family group). That adult will be the go-to person for their family group.

Please communicate to your student:

They are expected to be on time.

They will need to stay with their assigned family group leader.

They must always communicate with their family group leader on their location.

<u>All students and leaders</u> are required to stick to the schedule and the assigned group activities.

There will be a zero-tolerance policy for the following:

- At no time should there be a guy and girl together alone in a room.
- Students found outside their assigned hotel room after lights out and before wake-up.
- Any illegal activity.

If any of these should occur, the student's parent/guardian will be called, and the student will be sent home at the parent/guardian's expense. This is a large event with thousands of teenagers. It is vitally important that students adhere to these policies.

Upon arrival at The Barrymore Hotel, students and leaders will be meeting as a group. We will communicate room location through the Remind app. That information will be passed along utilizing the cell numbers you provided with your registration. If that number has changed, you have not given us a cell number, or if you are not receiving information and would like to, please contact Jason Riggle at (812) 230-2296.

Also, there will be an NYC app available for Android and Apple (Nazarene Youth Conference 2023). The app will provide all the latest information regarding NYC, a detailed itinerary of the events, speakers, bands, artists, maps, and more. All sessions of NYC 2023 will be live-streamed. Specific live streaming information will be made available once that information has been released.
