

Keynote Speaker



Dr. David Graves is one of six General Superintendents in the Church of the Nazarene. At the time of his election in 2009, he was senior pastor of College Church of the Nazarene in Olathe, Kansas. Prior to this he served as Director of Sunday School Ministries for the Church of the Nazarene. He has had pastoral assignments in Kansas, Ohio, Tennessee, Oklahoma, and North Carolina.

Dr. Graves is a graduate of Olivet Nazarene University and received his Master of Divinity degree from Nazarene Theological Seminary. Also, he received an honorary Doctor of Divinity from Olivet. He is the author of three books and has written for numerous publications.

Dr. Graves and his wife, Sharon, have four married children, Michael, John, Stephen, and Rachel, and 10 grandchildren. He is a fourth-generation Nazarene on both sides of his family.

Workshop Presenters & Descriptions



Dr. Dean Blevins is an ordained elder in the Church of the Nazarene and serves as Professor of Practical Theology and Christian Discipleship at Nazarene Theological Seminary. A prolific author, Dr. Blevins co-wrote the textbook Discovering Discipleship, and he edits Didache: Faithful Teaching, a journal for Wesleyan Education.

Workshop #1 for Adults: "You Can Get There From Here: Understanding and Leading With Millennials." This workshop explores the history that shapes and defines the millennial generation and implications for ministry both to and with the largest generational group in the U.S. During the workshop, participants will discuss millennial strengths, challenges, and concerns, as well as explore approaches that will lead to a holistic and lasting method of discipleship.

Workshop #2 for Adults: "WE Are the Church: Why Intergenerational Ministry Makes a Difference and What To Do About It." This workshop offers a basic argument for "why" intergenerational ministry proves important to the church particularly for the next generation and includes some basic approaches to implementing intergenerational strategies within the context of the local church.



Rev. Jill Waltz has been in full-time Christian ministry for over twenty years. She is passionate about training church leadership and challenging Christians to fight uninspired living. Jill holds a B.S. and Masters of Church Management from Olivet Nazarene University. She speaks and preaches to groups and churches across the country. She is an author and develops materials for church leaders.

Workshop #1 for Children: "Ministry to Spiritual Orphans." Scripture is clear that God designed parents to take the lead in the spiritual development/nurture of their children. Sadly, this isn't a reality for some kids. Ministering to kids that have never set foot in a church before can prove to be an eye-opening experience to seasoned ministry leaders. Learn to create a new culture and to practically minister to spiritual orphans.

Workshop #2 for Children: "Ministry to Families: Speed Bound." From recruiting and volunteer development to utilizing technology, ministry is ever evolving. This fast-paced session will cover a myriad of topics pertaining to family and children's ministry.

The Southwest Indiana District finds itself in a season of transition as it seeks to better fulfill its mission. After careful and prayerful consideration, the District Advisory Board voted on March 27th to list the district office with a realtor. For many years, the district has owned an office located in Bedford. This has not always been the case. Previously the office was located in the district parsonage.

Nazarene districts across the USA and Canada today, find themselves doing a variety of things regarding the district office:

Some have not owned an office for many years now.

Some have sold their office and are now leasing office space.

Some have an office in a district parsonage and maintain a separate living and office space with multiple entryways.

Some are renting space in a nearby Nazarene church.

Some have a more mobile office.

There are many factors we considered throughout this process. One of the biggest challenges involving our district office has been maintenance. Another factor that played into our decision was that of good stewardship with the resources God has given us. In recent conversations with the District Advisory Board, I requested we either needed to properly and consistently maintain our office or do something different. I presented a number of alternatives including leasing a small office, operating a mobile office with the base of the operation in the home I purchased or finding space in a nearby church. While we have no way of knowing if the district office will sell I wanted to make sure you knew of this decision and our intent. If the office does sell, please know we will continue to provide the best service we can while being good stewards.

Also, I want to inform you that Sandi Miller's time of service as office manager for SWID will be coming to an end, May 31st.

Considering all the change and transition, the decision was made to not re-employ her, per Manual Paragraph 245. We are grateful for her love and dedication that has kept SWID moving forward these past several years.

In the midst of this season of change and transition please know we will continue to serve each and every church and pastor on our district. Please pray as SWID continues to serve one another in love and fulfill Christ's commission. God bless you!!!
