

Are You Ready for Easter?

A NOTE FROM PASTOR TIM CRUMP

What would happen if we used the days prior to Easter to do what the Apostle Paul declared to the Church in Philippi?

"I want to know Christ and the power of his resurrection and the fellowship of sharing in his sufferings, becoming like him in his death, and so, somehow, to attain to the resurrection from the dead." -- Philippians 3:10-11

Would you join me and thousands of Christ followers across the world who want to know Christ, the power of His resurrection, the fellowship of sharing in his suffering and becoming like Him? These are truly amazing words coming from a man whose seeming purpose in life had been to gather up followers of Jesus and have them killed. But an encounter with Jesus, the Risen Savior, changed everything in Paul's life. Oh, how I long for you to know Christ! To know the power of the resurrection of Jesus and even the fellowship of sharing in his suffering and becoming like Him!

Lent is part of the historical Christian calendar and is celebrated by Catholics and some mainline Protestant churches and yes, even some Nazarenes. Although Lent's format has varied throughout the years, it has always been a time for God's people to open their hearts and minds to His grace and mercy through prayer, confession (Psalm 139:23-24), repentance, fasting, and giving to those less fortunate.

So often the focus of Ash Wednesday has been on what we might "sacrifice" or give up for the Lord for forty days. You will hear followers of Christ talk about giving up things like pop, chocolate, social media, and much more. This is a great beginning to this season, but don't simply deny yourself something - Get to know Christ! This is not a time simply to gain knowledge of the Savior but to deepen your relationship with Him. As you listen and learn from Him - do whatever He asks of you! Allow His mission to seek and to save those who are lost to become your mission. What if every day we shared the reason for our hope which is Christ Jesus our Lord? Imagine during the next forty days sharing Jesus to those you meet! It might change our lives and who know knows who might be transformed by our wonderful Lord and Savior. What if you choose to invite someone to church during the next forty days?

I don't know about you, but I want to Christ, and the power of His resurrection and the fellowship of sharing in his sufferings, becoming like him in his death...

I can't wait for Easter, but I am going to enjoy the journey!



Pastor Tim & Cindy Crump would like to thank you all for your continued prayers as Pastor Tim continues to recover from his eye surgery to repair a detached retina.




