

Time to Serve

I have often wondered what it would have been like to watch Jesus go through life. Did Jesus ever sigh or shake His head in disbelief? What was the expression on His face as the disciples argued about who was the greatest among them? Did a tear roll down His cheeks as He recognized that even those closest to Him did not comprehend who He was and what He was about to do?

One of the tasks a servant or slave had in Jesus' day was washing dirty feet. Since the major mode of transportation was walking, one can easily imagine how dirty feet could become. One such occasion involving Jesus and His disciples is mentioned in the gospels. Much to the amazement of the disciples whose feet are dirty, Jesus gets up and begins washing their feet - as he enters the role of a servant. How would you feel as you watched Jesus go around the room? What about when He begins to wash your dirty feet? Imagine Him washing the feet of Judas?

Then Jesus declared: "Now that I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also should wash one another's feet. I have set you an example that you should do as I have done for you. Very truly, I tell you, no servant is greater than his master, nor is a messenger greater than the one who sent him. Now that you know these things, you will be blessed if you do them." John 3:14-17

Haiti Earthquake:

A 7.2-magnitude earthquake hit Haiti on Saturday morning, causing widespread destruction in an area still recovering from Hurricane Matthew in 2016. Nearly 1,300 people have died, a number that will likely rise. At the same time, Tropical Depression Grace is dumping rain on the country, bringing fears of landslides or contaminated drinking water.

The Church of the Nazarene has four districts in the area near the epicenter, two of which are known to have sustained significant damage and one that has not been able to make a report yet. At least four churches were destroyed in a southern district, and one pastor has lost his house. One district superintendent says that the quake killed one church member, and the areas of Les Cayes, Leprete, Pestel, and Jeremie were hit especially hard.

Churches and individuals around the world can provide support through the Haiti Earthquake 2021 Fund. Donations will be used for immediate needs, including shelter, clean water, food, and medical supplies, as well as long-term needs in the months and years ahead.


