



SWID LIFELINE

S.W.I.D. Lifeline is a financial program designed to provide a solid financial base for Southwest Indiana District Work & Witness building projects. All LifeLine funds go 100% directly to the Work & Witness Project (building materials etc.)

Membership in Lifeline involves the contribution of \$10.00 or more each quarter or \$40.00 per year for the construction of buildings and building improvements on mission fields around the world or in ethnic areas of the United States and Canada.

All churches are encouraged to participate and a goal of 10% of the Morning Worship Average Attendance is the recommended lifeline membership. (Example: Morning Worship Average is 160, then 16 Lifeline members is the church's goal = \$640.)

Churches also receive 10% credit at the time of the project.

The 10% credit generally lags 1 year to 18 months before being credited.

This is best put on the pastor's year-end-report as other local benevolences.

Finances contributed to Lifeline helps distribute the cost of projects throughout the district by enabling everyone to supply material for the projects. Individuals going on the project trip are then responsible for their traveling, living, and insurance expenses only.

This allows more people to actually be able to participate in a trip.

Promotion is usually done in January as part of Volunteer Ministries. Bulletin Boards and especially speakers who can share actual trip experiences are recommended. Many times personal slides, pictures and power point presentations are available with the speakers.

Doug Jones is available for most services to give presentations.

SWID MISSION TRIP

Calling for team members (individuals, families, teen groups)

Where: Flagstaff, Arizona -Kinlani Church of the Nazarene

Plenty of room for campers, tents, RV's. Some classrooms within the church could be available for cots/air mattresses if needed.

When: Monday, June 10 to Friday, June 21, 2019

Work days listed above but individuals can arrive and leave according to their own schedule. Whatever time you can share will be useful.

Cost: Personal transportation cost will vary (drive, fly or take the train)—approx. 1600 miles one way. Fixed costs for insurance at \$1.25/da and food \$8/da (adult) for meals prepared at the worksite.

Project: Kinlani Nazarene Church (Navajo Congregation)

Anticipate: painting, floor tiling, suspended ceiling, interior door installation, bathroom fixtures, landscaping, and etc. Possible VBS depending on SWID team members.
