I did not realize it then but I now wonder did we within the USA in our desire to know the mission of God and contribute to missions fail to be missional? Did we think because we supported a missionary that was all that was expected or desired of us?

Every one of us who comprise SWID need to become missional! We can do it! Lives can be transformed where we live. People can get saved and sanctified in our neighborhoods. God is on the move! Would you become missional? What about your church? Isn't it time our churches become missional in their focus? Would you pray our district would become a missional movement for God? I am looking forward to a year of transformation! Already, reports of people getting saved and sanctified are coming in. People are being baptized and new Nazarenes are joining the movement of God in Southwest Indiana!
