Have You Ever Had One Of Those Days?

But look forward to the day the Church gathers! We truly need each other! These are challenging days, and more are apt to follow, but Jesus did not stand alone, nor should we! Outreach Project

Has your church been looking for a community outreach project?

The Cloverdale Church of the Nazarene has started assisting victims of house fires in their community. They provide an emergency relief tote for those who have experienced a house fire.

Each tote provides items that will help them with general hygiene care and a \$100 gift certificate to help them get on their feet. They place a note on the lid from their church helping the family to remember who donated the care package.

The totes they use are 18 gallons.

The cost of each tote is about \$10.00 or you may purchase 12 of them at Wal-Mart.com for \$112.97.

Totes contain the following items, but feel free to substitute as you see fit.

Family Items: Gift certificate \$100, Bible, shampoo, soap, toothpaste, bandaids, cough drops, pens or pencils, pad pf paper, lotion, eye drops, and kleenex.

Men Items: Toothbrush, deodorant, towel and washcloth, comb, and lip balm.

Women Items: Toothbrush, deodorant, towel and washcloth, comb, and lip balm.

Child Items: Toothbrush, deodorant, towel, and a washcloth. Depending on the child's age coloring books and crayons or Children's books.

Other Items: You may put a blanket, quilt, and/or pillow in the tote as well.
